

## **Help Guide Our Work: Submit a Resolution**

Resolutions serve to guide TAASA's work within the sexual assault movement. Resolutions that are submitted by, approved and enacted by TAASA membership are of the utmost importance to the agency. Resolutions that are submitted for approval by the membership should be thoughtful and directly related to the purposes and principles of TAASA. All resolutions should be consistent with TAASA's mission statement:

The Texas Association Against Sexual Assault (TAASA) is committed to ending sexual violence in Texas through education, prevention, and advocacy. In the meantime, we desire to support survivors on their paths to hope, healing and justice. TAASA is the voice of the sexual assault movement in Texas. We are a unifying force bringing together parties involved in and affected by sexual assault as a catalyst for change.

The following guidelines are required to formally submit a resolution for approval at the TAASA Annual Membership meeting:

- You must be a current TAASA member.
- Completed resolution request forms and resolution forms should be submitted to TAASA no later than Jan. 13.
- Proposed resolutions shall be posted on TAASA website for membership review no later than Jan. 30.
- Membership shall vote on proposed resolutions during the Annual Membership meeting at TAASA's Annual Conference, Monday, March 1, 3:15 – 4:45 p.m. at the Isla Grand Resort.

Unless renewed, resolutions automatically expire four years after passage.
